St. George's Boarding House, Harker Hall, is located at the Junior School campus. These residences include 24-hour live-in supervisors, a fully qualified nurse, an infirmary, and a dining hall that provides Canadian and international meals. Students share rooms with 1, 2 or 3 others. Each room provides a desk and ample storage space. Each floor has a lounge where students can socialize and play games or table tennis.

All students will receive laundry service and access to telephones and the internet.

A unique and exciting Canadian experience

The Summer Boarding Program at St. George's School offers total immersion in Canadian living and learning. We offer traditional English language or immersion studies, evening hobby classes and many tours. Local Canadian teachers and staff live with students in the boarding residence.

THE CURRICULUM

Offering students unique options

COURSE OPTIONS:

- **English Classes:** International students will receive English classes from 9 - 3:30 on weekdays with touring, cultural activities, and specialized programs in the evenings. Weekends will consist of full-day tours.
- **Immersion Option:** A wide range of day camp courses (www.summeratstgeorges.ca) is available to Native English-speaking boarding students from 9-3:30. Boarding Program fees are inclusive of Day Camp tuition.
- **Intensive English:** International students planning to attend school in Canada or those looking for a greater academic challenge may choose this program which includes an hour of homework each night.

All boarding students will participate in evening programs. Choices may include tennis, robotics, baking, photography, Native Canadian Arts, and more. Each weekend, all students will tour Vancouver and participate in fun Canadian activities.



IN THE CLASSROOM

Engaging each student

English classes are small so students can learn practical speaking and listening skills. Our Canadian teachers are government qualified and are able to help students with a variety of English language levels. St. George's English classes help students develop confident skills in writing, speaking, listening, spelling, pronunciation and grammar.

Immersion classes in our day camps run from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm with a short lunch break. Students may choose any suitable day camp and they will enjoy a variety of exciting activities each day with local Vancouver children.
